SUBJECT: MODEL EX3116 APPLICATION TO EARLIER PRODUCTION ENGINES

It is now possible to convert certain Caterpillar 3116 engines built prior to changeover in 1992 to the high backpressure capability. This will make possible the installation of the Extarder Model EX3116.

The following guidelines must be followed:

All 1991 and later 3116's may be converted to the high backpressure capability. These have the serial prefix "2BK".

Earlier "7SF" prefix engines, 215 and 250 HP may also be converted.

IMPORTANT: "7SF" prefix engines, 165 - 185 HP MUST NOT be converted.

Jacobs recommends that this conversion be accomplished at an approved Caterpillar engine dealer.

A list of the parts required to convert the 3116 engine to the higher backpressure capability is attached for reference. ADVISOR PROBLEM
